Please ensure that your Application has been submitted successfully.

Until you obtain your Academic Identification Card you can use the Student Card issued by your <u>Home University</u> in order to be entitled to reduced fares (for students aged up to 25 years).

INFO FOR COVID-19 & THE CONDUCTION OF COURSES

According to the latest announcement of the Ministry of Education and Religious Affairs the courses in the spring semester 2021-22 will be held by physical presence.

You will have access to the classrooms only if:

- you are fully vaccinated (14 Day period has elapsed since the last vaccination dose). You are advised to have the QR Code or a copy of your COVID vaccination Certificate (digital or printed).
- you have been infected and have recovered from COVID-19. The time mediated by the positive test result should be between 20 days(min.) to less than 180 days (max.).

Non vaccinated students will have to get tested twice a week in private diagnostic centers with PCR (~45 Euros/test) or Rapid Test (~8 Euros/test) at their expense. The test should be taken twice per week 48 hours before Tuesday and Friday. The result of the test should be inserted into the governmental platform: gov.gr in order to attend classes (you will be further informed by the secretariat of each Department).
